Wall Pre-Installation Measuring Guide



NOTE: Installation Guide is generalized for **most** types of installations and is intended to help plan for simple & easy installation & product usage. Personal & specific structural physicalities may require deviation from the recommended measurements. Plan for the front bar to pitch downward at a minimum of 12.5 inches from the installation height.

Example: Install height = 8 ft., therefore the front bar will be 7 ft. 6 inches from the ground.

Planning Your Awning Installation Height & Location.


Locate an area that is

- Recommended 8 to 10 ft. above the ground/floor/deck etc.
- B Recommended
 Minimum of 1 inch
 clearance below the
 roof/eave/overhang
 etc.
- Critical
 Minimum of 10 inches
 clear vertical run
 length, depending on
 awning size.





Run length should be free & clear of any obstructions along the entirety of planned awning length.
